until summer.

fall out

to have a
relationship be
strained or end
after an argument

I fell out with Janice
because she stole my
boyfriend.

fall down

when a person or
structure falls to the
ground

I slipped on the ice and
fell down.

fall back on

have the option to use
something if other
plans aren't successful

If he loses his job during
the recession, he has
money to fall back on.
