

# PHRASAL VERBS with FALL

**fall apart**

break into pieces

That chair looks like it would fall apart if you sat in it.

**fall behind**

not make sufficient progress to stay on schedule

We fell behind on the project and submitted it late.

**fall through**

be unsuccessful (usually with plans)

I was going to visit my sister this weekend, but my plans fell through because my car broke down.

**fall for**

fall in love; develop a romantic attraction to someone

I can't stop thinking about Craig. I think I'm falling for him!
