act on / act upon

 to do something because you have been given information, advice, or orders
 I am acting on the advice of my lawyer.



• fail to function properly
Our car engine was acting up, so we took it to a mechanic.



ACT

• to misbehave, especially when unhappy or stressed
The child acted out because his mother wouldn't buy him a toy.
