

Phrasal Verbs



cut back on (something)

- to consume less

Sam cut back on sugary sweets.



cut in

- to interrupt a conversation

I was trying to talk to Ben, but my sister kept cutting in.



cut (someone) off

- to take out of a will; disinherit

His parents cut him off after he quit college.



cut (something) out

- to remove something smaller from something larger

I cut the article out of the newspaper.
