STAY UP

to be awake with the intent to go to bed later than usual

The parents let their children stay up until midnight on New Year's Eve.

RING IN

to celebrate the arrival of a special occasion, especially the New Year

We will ring in the New Year with friends in New York.

GO OFF

to make a loud noise or explosion

My niece always gets scared when fireworks go off.

COUNT DOWN

to count backward usually to mark an event that is about to happen (for example: 10, 9, 8...1)

People counted down the last ten seconds before midnight.

LOOK FORWARD TO

to be excited about something in the future

I'm looking forward to our New Year's Eve party tonight!
