

Phrasal Verbs: Travel

What's a phrasal verb?

A phrasal verb is made up of a verb plus a preposition or an adverb

CHECK OUT

pay the bill when leaving a hotel

Jen checked out of the hotel and took a taxi to the airport.

GET AWAY

take a vacation, especially because you need a rest

I would love to get away and go to the beach next week.

STOP OVER

stay at a place for a night (or more) on the way to somewhere else

They stopped over in Singapore on their way to Australia.

SEE OFF

go to the place someone is leaving from to say goodbye

We took Jane to the airport to see her off.
