What's the difference?



Say + something (+ to someone)

Ron said something really funny to me.

Say + "that" clause

John said that he received good news.

Say + "wh-" noun clause

Jen didn't say when she would return.

Say + to + verb

My teacher always says to work hard.



Tell + someone + something.

Nobody told Jim about the meeting.

Sara told Bob the good news.

EXCEPTIONS: Tell + a lie Tell + a story
Ben has never told a lie. Tell + the truth
