- Subject pronoun
- Takes the place of a subject
- Does the action

Heidi drove to New York City.
I drove to New York City.



Jane and Heidi studied.
Jane and **I** studied.



ME

- Object pronoun
- Takes the place of an object
- Receives the action

Tina gave Heidi a present.
Tina gave **me** a present.



Tina gave Jane and Heidi a present.
Tina gave Jane and **me** a present.
